Preparing For Your Treatment



Kitchen

- ☐ Place all food items in sealed containers and remove them from treatment area
- ☐ Empty out all cupboards and food pantries (pots, pans, food items)
- ☐ Empty out all items from drawers (towels and utensils)
- ☐ Clean and remove all items from countertops, small appliances (Microwave, toaster, etc.) can remain
- ☐ Clean underneath the stove and fridge. Ensure warming drawer below oven is empty
- ☐ Please remove and ensure any competing food sources/spills from all areas listed above
- ☐ Ensure to keep all removed items within the kitchen area and covered properly to prevent cockroaches from spreading to other areas



Bathroom

- ☐ Clear out all items from counter top, cabinets, and sink vanity drawers
- ☐ Ensure access to all plumbing lines under sinks are clear.



Living Areas & Bedroom

- ☐ Move furniture at least 2 feet away from the wall. Expose all baseboard to allow access for treatment
- ☐ Vacuum floors and remove excessive clutter
- ☐ Unplug all cords from outlets



Pets

- ☐ Birds and Pets must be removed from the premise for 6 hours. Fish tanks must be covered and pumps turned off

Treatment Process

Our residual spray treatment creates a long-lasting barrier to eliminate cockroaches over time. After application, you may see increased activity for 24-48 hours as pests come into contact with the treated surfaces. Do not clean treated areas for at least 48 hours, and avoid using other pesticides, as they can reduce effectiveness. Regular cleaning and proper food storage will help maintain results. If you have any concerns, please notify your Technician before treatment begins

After Your Treatment

The effectiveness of the treatment depends on following these essential steps after service to ensure long-lasting results.

- Re-entry Time: You may enter your home 4 hours after treatment unless otherwise instructed by your technician.
- Increased Pest Activity: You may notice more cockroaches or other pests immediately after treatment. They may become disoriented, wander, and die soon after.
- DO NOT use other pest control chemicals (powders or sprays) or cleaning products near treated areas, as this will decrease or eliminate the effectiveness of the treatment.
- Follow Technician Recommendations for any necessary repairs to seal entry points and prevent future infestations.
